In order to motivate our students to try their very best to attend school daily, we have provided the following incentives:

- **Half Day Wednesday's Dress Down**
 - Students who had perfect attendance between every half day Wednesday and the Friday before the next Half Day Wednesday will receive a free dress down ticket.
- **Classroom Incentive**

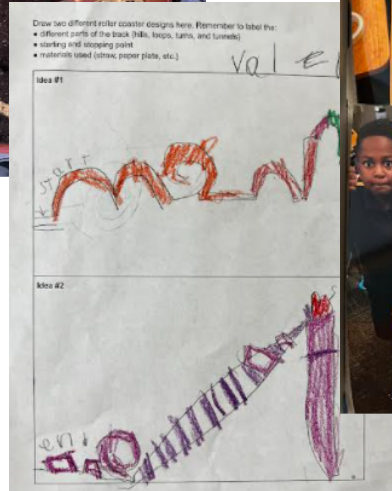

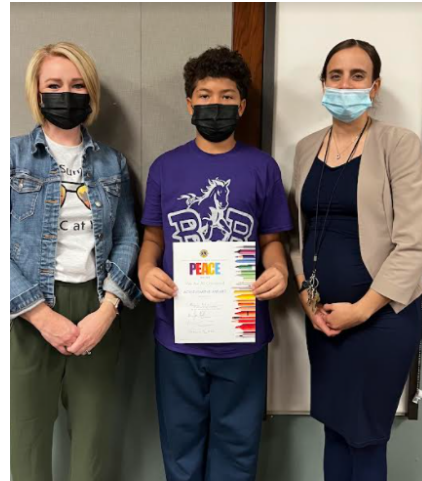
Our Mission
