

Our kindergarten through 5th grade students completed the Bullying Prevention unit from our Social-Emotional curriculum. We have seen an increased amount of students supporting each other and advocating for themselves. In this unit, students learned how to do the following:

- Recognize when bullying is happening
- Report bullying to a caring adult
- Refuse to let bullying happen to themselves or others
- Be a bystander who stands up and is part of the solution to bullying

Our 6th-8th grade students will continue this unit for the remainder of the 2nd quarter. The lessons will focus on how to recognize the social and environmental factors that can enable bullying and harassment, how to safely challenge these factors, and how to seek help if they or someone they know is being bullied or harassed.



We have reader's! Our kinder teachers have been working hard to ensure our students have strong phonological awareness and phonics skills to build as a foundation as they become reader's. This month our kinder students have begun to partner read with their Spalding decodables. This is SO exciting to see and hear! Great job kindergarten!!!





The level of critical thinking, conceptual understanding, student engagement was HIGH in **Mr. Zermeno's** math class! Mr. Zermeno created intentional bellwork that aligned back to the lesson objective to engage the students to activate their prior knowledge when they first entered the classroom. The students also created a TRIPLE bubble map comparing and contrasting. The students built on each other's level of understanding during their student to student dialogue.
