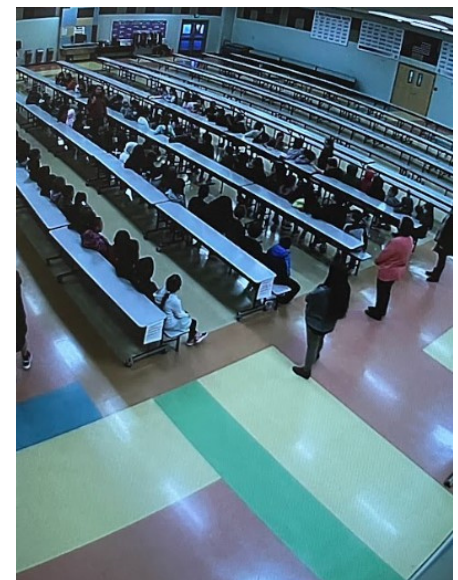

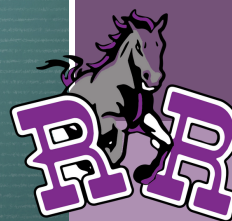
STEM Vision Statement
