SWEATSHIRTS/SWEATERS/JACKETS: ALL WHITE, NAVY, GRAY OR BLACK

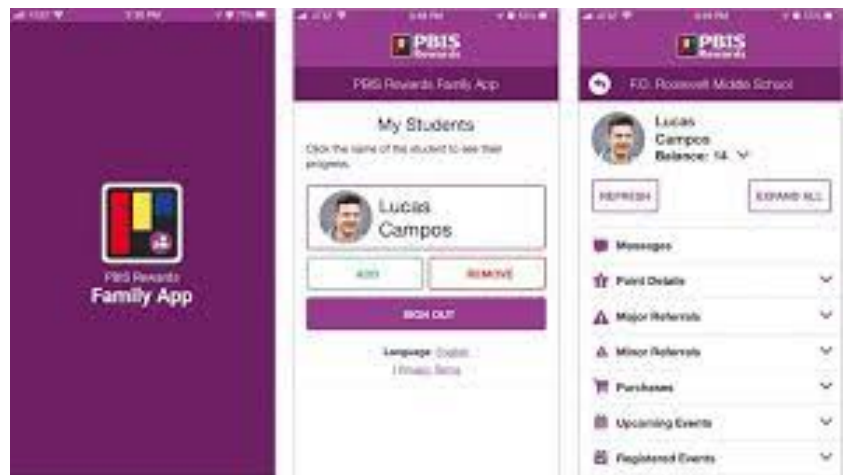


BOTTOMS: SOLID BLACK, NAVY OR KHAKI PANTS, SHORTS, SKORTS, SKIRTS OR JUMPERS

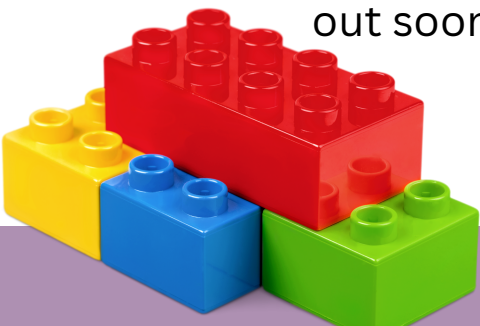

More information will be sent out soon! Be on the look out!

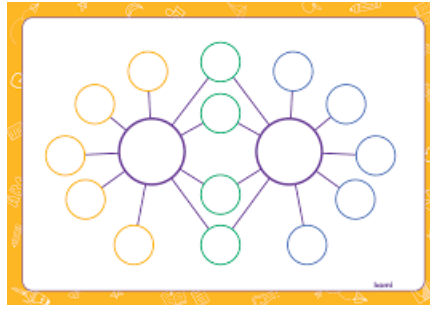


STEM Vision Statement

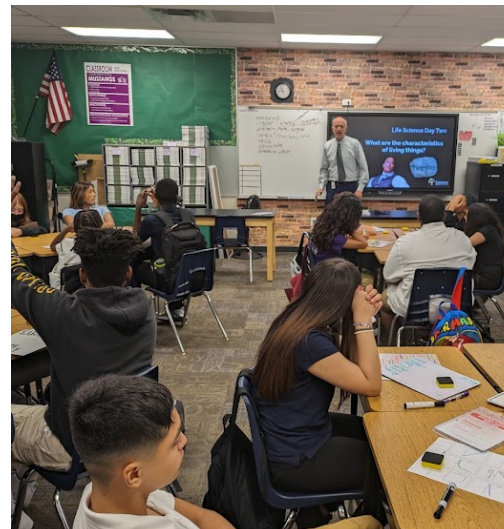
Mrs. Long and her 5th grade students using a double bubble map to compare & contrast character traits.
