
### A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL, DR. G

#### MUSTANGS RIDE WITH P.R.I.D.E


Our first day of school is Monday, August 5th. The first bell will ring at 8:20 a.m., and the final bell will ring at 8:30 a.m. (this will be the bell schedule for the entire school year). It is critical that students arrive on time each and every day to maximize their learning in the classroom. Late students must go through the front office to get a tardy pass. On the first day of school, families will NOT be allowed onto campus. The exception is that our Kindergarten families can walk their student(s) to the DOOR of their Kindergarten classroom for the FIRST week of school ONLY. The Kindergarten gate is located on the South side of campus.

#### SCHOOL YEAR UPDATES FOR 4TH & 5TH GRADE

This school year, RRSA's fourth and fifth grade will be departmentalized. This means that students will have four different teachers specializing in a content area (Reading/Writing, Math, Science, and Social Studies). We are thrilled to provide this opportunity for students to continue their academic growth.

#### ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL

**Arrival:** We have two locations that you can drop students off:

- 1. South lot-students will walk around to the front gate
- 2. Front lot

In either location, we are asking that parents **pull all the way forward** to help the flow of traffic in the morning. The "please pull forward" signs will be located at both locations to assist families in adhering to our safety expectations.

**Dismissal:** The front gate will not open until the bell rings at 3:30 PM daily. We do ask that parents refrain from going up to the double gate doors so that we can open the gate promptly. Please see the photo of the safest spot to stand while waiting to pick up students at the front gate.

We will continue to block off the front lot at 3:10 following selfcontained dismissal. Please park on the street to pick up students, as many are walkers, and this ensures their safety.




