ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL REMINDERS

Arrival: We have two locations that you can drop students off: 1. South lot-students will walk around to the front gate 2. Front lot

In either location, we are asking that parents **pull all the way forward** to help the flow of traffic in the morning. The "please pull forward" signs will be located at both locations to assist families in adhering to our safety expectations. In addition, please do not park in the driveline and walk your students in rather park in the lot and use the crosswalk.

Dismissal: The front gate will not open until the bell rings at 3:30 PM daily. We do ask that parents refrain from going up to the double gate doors so that we can open the gate promptly.

We will continue to block off the front lot at 3:10 following self-contained dismissal. Please park on the street to pick up students, as many are walkers, and this ensures their safety.

For driveline families, we ask that you pull forward as much as possible when the opportunity arises so that we can continuously load students.
